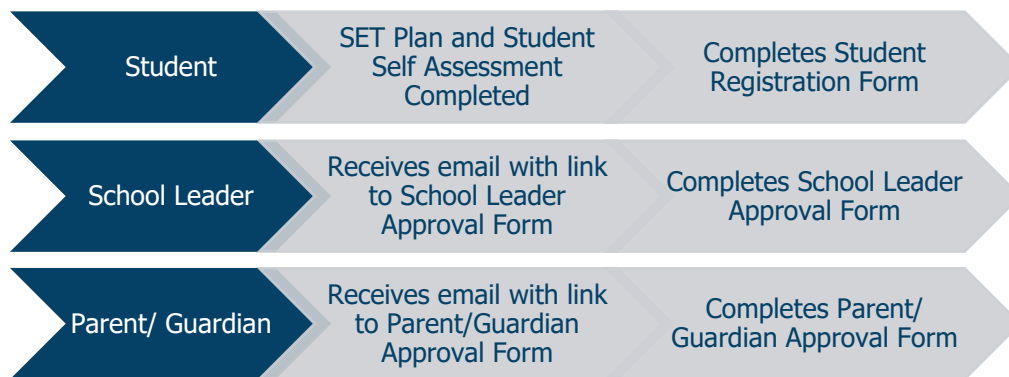


Enrolling in FisherONE

St John Fisher College – Online Education (FisherONE)

Students can enrol in single subjects through St John Fisher College Online Education (FisherONE). The subjects on offer in 2023 are: Ancient History, Business, Design, Digital Solutions, Japanese, Modern History, Music, Physics and Specialist Mathematics. The closing date for guaranteed enrolment is **11 November, 2022**. For 2023 subject offerings, the enrolment form is completed in three parts:



Students

1. Engage in the SET planning process at your school.
2. Complete the online learning self-assessment and discuss online learning with the person responsible for senior subjects at your school.
3. Begin the [registration process using this link](#) (it is also available on the St John Fisher College website)

School Leader (DP/AP Curriculum or Head of Senior Schooling)

1. Meet with the student and their guardian to discuss their self-assessment and whether online learning is the best mode for the student.
2. Once you receive an email notifying you of the student's registration commencing, complete the school leader approval form that is linked in the email. You will need:
 - Student's name
 - Student's school email address
 - Student's LUI
 - Subject/s they wish to study
3. You will be notified once the application is complete (the parent approves the application after you) and when it is accepted.
4. If the student decides not to proceed or if the school does not support the application, please [cancel the registration using this link](#).
5. Schools will be invoiced after Week 4 of Term 1, 2023. Please arrange payment of the invoice.

Students and Guardians

1. Engage in the SET planning process at your child's school and discuss your child's self-assessment with them and/or the school leader to determine whether online learning is the best option.
2. Once you receive an email for the parent/guardian approval form linked, complete this form.
3. Arrange a meeting with the appropriate leader in their school to discuss the enrolment.

Acceptance of Enrolment

Students and school supervisors will be emailed to inform them of the outcome of their application. Schools will be invoiced after Week 4 of Term 1, 2023. A registration fee of \$100 per student will be non-refundable.
